It is divided into six regions:

- Africa
- Asia (AFCMA)
- Australia and New Zealand
- Europe (FEAMC)
- North America
- Latin America (FAMCLAM)

The aims of FIAMC are listed in its official Statutes and are summarised as follows.

- To coordinate the efforts of Catholic Medical Associations in the study and spread of Christian principles throughout the world.
- To encourage the development of Catholic Medical Associations in all countries, in order to assist Catholic Physicians in their moral, spiritual and professional development.
- To participate in the general development of the medical profession and to promote healthcare and social action in accordance with the Magisterium of the Catholic Church.
- To devote itself to the study of medical ethical problems with their practical and theoretical solutions.
- To establish models of cooperation in health and pastoral care with developing countries.

At the request of John-Paul II, one of the primary missions of FIAMC is the protection, promotion and safeguarding of human life within the different cultures.

Since its foundation FIAMC has organized world Congresses every 4 years. This is the first occasion that it is being held in Lourdes.

FIAMC has its permanent secrétariat in Rome. Its president is Dr José-Maria Simón-Castellvi, from Barcelona.

PRESENTATION

- Participation in the usual Liturgies and other ceremonies is planned (Eucharistic procession, torchlit Marian procession, international Mass), with the possibility of joining in with other highlights of Lourdes: The baths, Rosary, Stations of the Cross, confession ...
