Maybe the congress will be postponed to 2010 because of an European congress on Stem Cells in Monaco 2009. (Dr Zwicky) --Health Care in Africa (Dr X. Sanz) 	<p><i>Zpráva prezidenta:</i></p> <p>Dr Simon emphasizes that FEAMC is an important branch of the World Federation. FEAMC is a federation in which many countries are offering many activities and much commitment. FEAMC has got a great impact in different institutions. The new member countries are bringing new possibilities. The Holy See is very glad with FEAMC. FIAMC itself is participating in a new edition of Humanae Vitae, in the next congress of catholic obstetricians and in the congress in Rome on Organ Donation. In Monaco 2009 a congress on Stem Cells will take place probably November 26th till 27th 2009.</p> <p>Dr Simon is grateful.</p> <p>The president considers the activities of the FEAMC during the last four years. FEAMC has 23 associations, 19 of them are active. All together we count about 10.000 members.</p> <p>There is a good contact with other countries and with a number of institutions.</p> <p>Most associations have got problems because of the greying of many members. Croatia, France and Portugal have some more young members. Especially with Croatia the contact is important because of the next congress for young doctors.</p> <p>During the last four years the meetings of the FEAMC took place in: Rome, Bucharest, Matran (Switzerland), Barcelona, Rome, Arnhem, Lisbon and Prague.</p> <p>We have a good staff, many board members with special functions and many links.</p> <p>The website has to be revitalised and to be continued. Thanks to Italy we have enjoyed many editions of the Bulletin. This has to be continued too.</p> <p>The president thanks all officers. There is much work and a great challenge for the new board.</p>

<p><i>Gdaňská deklarace:</i></p> <p>- The majority of the members of the board like to omit the introductory paragraph of the Declaratio (voting: for 12 against 2 abstention 1)</p> <p>- Dr Jessiman remarks about point 7 that the mentioned eugenic abortion differs essentially from the problems at the end of life.</p> <p>- Prof. Anzani says that we have to move our method of working towards people who are believing in the dignity of human life. We have to demonstrate our catholic way of living.</p> <p>- Prof Laureano Santos says we must not be thinking in terms of guilt and danger. We better may support and promote the good basis of life in a positive approach.</p> <p>- Dr Stevens thinks that in point the protection of our children must be formulated stronger. (have to protect in stead of we wish to protect)</p> <p>He will also say something about the recent anxiety in Middle and Eastern Europe about the political developments in Georgia. 8 members are against politicizing FEAMC, 6 members are for. Nevertheless the board likes to approach Stevens' opinion by adding to the people's need the word existential need.</p>	<p><i>Gdaňská deklarace:</i></p> <p>- The Polish Association requests urgently to take up again the paragraph which the board of the FEAMC omitted two days before. Before the voting are five speakers:

- Prof. Boscia, vice-president of AMCI speaks in favour of professor Anzani

- Dr Blin : will continue the friendly climate we experienced during the presidency of professor Marek. He likes FEAMC having a position in the Council of Europe. Besides he will promote the contact with the Lourdes Association.

- Professor Anzani unfolds his program: we have a catholic way of life and we will demonstrate this. He pleas for a new way of working in FEAMC

- Dr Stevens and professor Laureano Santos tell their curriculum vitae

The president appoints the members of the voting committee: dr Rudolf Giertlel and professor Jasinka Markeljevic. The number of voters is 34.

New president of the FEAMC:

Dr Blin 17 votes, prof Anzani 16 votes, 1 abstention. Francois Blin will be the new president of the FEAMC. He thanks the general assembly for the confidence.

New secretary general:

Hans Stevens 32 votes, 2 abstentions, 0 against. Hans Stevens will be the new secretary general of the FEAMC

New treasurer:

Alexandre Laureano Santos 34 votes, no abstentions, 0 against. Alexandre Laureano Santos will be the new treasurer of the FEAMC.
